Back To School 2022 COVID SAFE MEASURES

Face Masks

- * Masks are compulsory for all students in years 7-12 and will be required to be worn both indoors & outdoors, unless they are seated or able to maintain a 1.5m distance from others.
- * All students in Years 3 to 6 will be strongly encouraged to wear masks when physical distancing is not possible
- * Volunteers, family members, contractors and other visitors are required to wear a face mask while on school grounds, unless they are seated or physical distancing of 1.5m can be maintained.

Limiting Activity on Campus.

* To limit visitors on our campuses, aside from parents and carers of Prep, Year 1, or vulnerable students, where possible, we ask parents and carers to drop off and pick up children in a safe place at entrances instead of entering the school. * WCC will be limiting face-to-face staff meetings, parent-teacher interviews and professional development during the first four weeks. *School camps, excursions, assemblies (including our Senior Leadership Badge Ceremony), and

large gatherings have been postponed until

further notice. Stayed tuned for revised dates!!

Standard Hygiene Measures

- * staff, students, children or visitors are asked to stay home if sick.
- * If a student becomes sick at school, parents/carers will be contacted to collect their child. Students should not return to school until they are well.
- * If a student tests positive, a letter will be sent home to the specific class to notify parents/carers.
- * WCC will be encouraging and supporting regular hand washing and sanitising.
- * There will be an increased focus on facility cleaning, particularly high-frequency touchpoints such as door handles, light switches, desks and water fountains or bubblers, play equipment, and playgrounds.
