







What is your child learning?

English

Students will engage with narrative texts, retelling familiar stories and sharing their opinion. They will explore a variety of comprehension strategies to apply to their reading.

Maths

Students will work with numbers to 120 and explore skip counting and number patterns. They will also collect and record data, representing and comparing it in different ways.

Science

Students will learn about push and pull and how force changes the motion and shape of objects. They will make predictions, conduct investigations as well as record and share their observations.

HASS

Students will explore continuity and change in family structures, roles and significant aspects of daily life over time.

Health & PE

Students will learn the skills of handball to play by the rules in partner and team games. They will explore health information and explain why it is important for making choices.

The Arts

Students will explore emotions, experimenting with a range of materials and processes.

Technologies

Students will continue to learn digital and design skills to apply to scenarios.
