

Try for 5 Program

The 'Try for 5' Program is run by NRL teams, the North Queensland Cowboys and Brisbane Broncos to promote attendance through inter-class and inter-school competitions across eight schools in Queensland. Ambassadors *Matt Bowen*, *Scott Prince*, *Brent Tate* and *Justin Hodges* will be working with schools to motivate students, staff, families and communities.

The aim of the program is to increase student attendance by focusing on attending school 5 days per week.

There are two levels of competition -

Class vs Class competition: Prizes and a special, personalised video message go to the class with the highest attendance at the end of each reporting fortnight. Particular students who have made big improvements can also receive special mention in the video message.

School vs School competition: Each of the eight schools compete against their own comparative attendance data for the same period in 2015.

WCC's Ambassador, **Matt Bowen**, will engage with students and families in a variety of activities at the end of Terms 2, 3, and 4.
