

## **Bring Your Own Device**

When purchasing a device online or at the store, please be aware of the school's minimum specifications. These specifications: relate to the suitability of the device to enable class activities, meet student needs and promote safe and secure access to the department's network.

If you already own a functioning laptop, it can be brought to school as a learning device. Please make sure it meets the recommended requirements. Contact our IT team to analyse your device if you need assistance.

## **Recommended Requirements for Device Selection**

- Windows 10 Operating System
- 8GB RAM
- Pentium Silver N6000, Intel i3 CPU or equivalent
- Internal SSD 128GB or greater
- Operating System Windows 10
- Wi-Fi connectivity (802.11n – minimum with 802.11ac – recommended)
- Battery – at least 6 hours working life
- Ports: USB, audio in/out, in-built microphone, VGA or HDMI, camera

- Office 365 (free download for students)
- Case and bag for protection
- Windows defender (free) or Norton Anti-Virus
- Warranty and accidental damage protection
