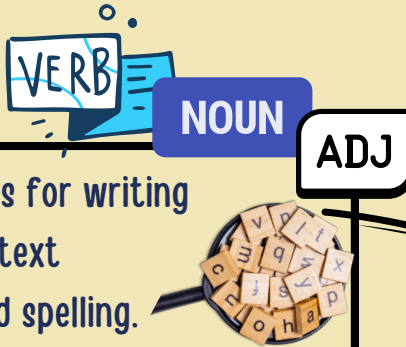


What is your child learning?

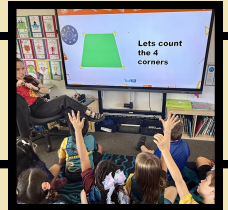
This document has been produced to increase communication between school and home.

Students will explore skills for writing procedures focussing on text structure, vocabulary and spelling.

Maths



Students will learn to use modelling and calculation strategies to solve problems. They will also investigate shapes through the use of spatial terms and locating, positioning and following directions in a 2D representation.

Health and PE



Students will learn water safety, swimming and survival skills to help keep themselves and others safe in and around water. Students will develop hand-eye co-ordination and use space effectively to practise ball skills.

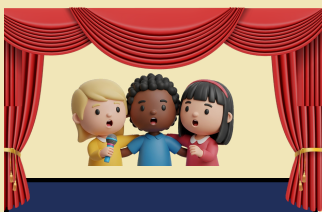


Science

The Arts



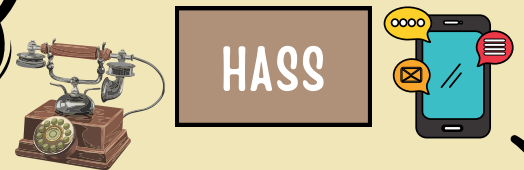
Students devise, perform and respond to dramatic play focusing on the role, situation and ideas expressed.
