

WHAT IS YOUR CHILD LEARNING?

THIS DOCUMENT HAS BEEN PRODUCED TO INCREASE COMMUNICATION BETWEEN SCHOOL AND HOME.

English:

Students will be listening to, reading and viewing poems. They will analyse the purpose, structure and theme of poems. They will also learn to create poems on various topics, drawing on 'the senses' as inspiration.

Mathematics:

Students will build their multiplication and division skills using a range of strategies and quick recall of facts. They will explore fractions by showing and representing them in different ways, and they will take part in simple chance experiments to describe and explain how likely different outcomes are.

Science:

Students will learn to conduct investigations about solids and liquids changing state when heat is added or taken away. This will involve making predictions and recording observations.

HASS:

Students will continue to identify and interpret data about Australian places through different maps. They will explain the importance of making decisions democratically.

Health and Physical Education:

Students will explore movement through water based rescue activities and problem solve for hazardous situations. They will also learn the fundamental skills of field hockey through passing trapping, dribbling and shooting.

The Arts:

In drama, students will learn to devise, perform and respond to a drama based on storytelling.

Technologies:

Students will consolidate learning around digital systems and data safety. They will continue their learning around designing for a scenario and coding an Edison robot.
