

What is your child learning?

TERM 3, 2025

ENGLISH:

Students will read historical recounts, including 'Eliza Bird' and answer comprehension questions about the text. They will be learning to create their own historical recount from differing viewpoints.

MATHS:

Students will represent tenths and hundredths in decimal form and multiplying by 10. They will also form connections between fractions, equivalence and decimal notation. They will learn how to conduct chance experiments and order events and outcomes in terms of likelihood.

SCIENCE:

Students will investigate the properties of different materials. They will conduct experiments about the observable properties of ochre mixtures and explain how they can be used in real-life situations.

HASS:

Students will explore James Cook's first journey and look at how and why life changed for different groups of people over time. They will recognise the importance of laws in society.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

In Health, students will learn to describe and apply protective behaviours and help-seeking strategies to keep themselves and others safe online.

In PE, students will learn to refine striking and fielding skills in cricket associated games.

THE ARTS

In Visual Art, students will use examine and create collaborative artwork based on pattern and surfaces in the local environment.

TECHNOLOGIES

Students will design and build a small kitchen garden; exploring sustainability, food production, and digital tools to plan and present their work. They will grow produce, prepare a healthy snack, document their process, and complete a mini project on digital citizenship and online safety.
