WHAT IS YOUR CHILD LEARNING?

English

Students will read and view novels and their film adaptations. They will learn to create a persuasive podcast for comparison whilst also developing their speaking, listening and interacting skills.

Maths

Students will make estimations and check the reasonableness of their calculations. They will multiply and divide large numbers as well as identify patterns in multiples and factors. Students will create and use algorithms involving a sequence of steps and decisions to experiment with factors, multiples and divisibility. They will estimate likelihoods, conduct investigations, record observations and frequencies as well as compare outcomes.

Science

Students will explain how the form and behaviour of animals with adaptations enables survival. They will identify and explain safety and intercultural considerations when planning field work.

HASS

Students will investigate democratic values and processes in the school community, describing different views on how to respond to an issue or challenge.

LOTE (Auslan)

Students will continue to learn to identify and use signs to describe similarities, differences and quantities.

Technologies

Students will design and create a functional game controller using suitable materials and a Makey Makey kit. They will document their design process in a detailed plan and capture key moments to produce a short video showcasing their project.

Health & PE

Students will learn movement, rescue and resuscitation skills in and around water to keep themselves and other safe. They will also learn to work as a team in invasion games that require ball control, strategic movement and play.

The Arts

Students will depict natural disasters and their impacts by making and responding through drama.
