English

Students will learn to read, view and listen to advertisements in print and digital media. They will develop skills to create their own multimodal advertisements.

Maths

Students will learn to order and perform operations involving fractions, decimals and percentages. They will represent measurement, solve unit conversions, and identify angles, area and the parallel cross-section of prisms.

Science

Students will learn how to classify and compare changes to substances. They will plan and conduct investigations, make predictions, record findings to analyse results, pose questions for further exploration and make reasoned conclusions.

HASS

Students will continue to investigate the Australian Federation through a guided inquiry. They will explain Australia's levels of government and democratic values using primary and secondary sources.

Technologies


Students will explore elements of Design and Digital Technologies. They will be introduced to design using tools and software and investigate their digital footprint.
