

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING



English

Students will learn to examine and create persuasive spoken texts. They will examine the structure, language features, vocabulary and literary devices of persuasive texts.



Science

Students will learn how to group and compare living and non-living things for a variety of life cycles. They will learn to use scientific vocabulary when communicating ideas and findings.



Mathematics

Students will learn to work with numbers beyond 10 000 and investigate 3D objects for key features. They will explore maps of familiar environments and conduct statistical investigations involving differing types of data and compare results.



The Arts

In Music, students will compose, perform and respond to music by exploring ways music can represent characters and their actions.



Technologies

Students will learn how digital systems work, and how to safely navigate their data online.



Humanities and Social Science (HASS)

Students will investigate the significance of ANZAC Day commemorations for different groups, aspects that have changed and remained the same over time as well as how and why people participate and contribute.



Health and Physical Education (HPE)

Students will learn about influences that strengthen their identity and develop strategies to overcome emotions and change. They will learn fundamental skills of volleyball and solve movement challenges using strategy, cooperation and fair play.
