What is your child learning?

This document has been produced to increase communication between school and home.

ENGLISH

Students will read "The Twits" by Roald Dahl. They will analyse the languages features used by the author to set the scene and build tension. They will also learn how create their own humorous new chapter based on a prank by Mr and Mrs Twit.

MATHEMATICS

Students will learn the properties of odd and even numbers to follow and create algorithms and identify patterns. Students will explore different types of angles, investigate shapes and objects in the environment and identify lines of symmetry in different shapes. They will use grid references to locate places on simple maps.

SCIENCE

Students will conduct investigations about how contact and non-contact forces are exerted on an object. This will include designing, making predictions, collecting data and identifying patterns.

HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES (HASS)

Students use grid references on maps to identify the location of landmarks of different countries. They will investigate the similarities and differences of different environments and interpret data to describe patterns.

TECHNOLOGIES

Students will be exploring elements of Design and Digital Technologies. They will use Microsoft Word and PowerPoint, as well as Minecraft Education and practice coding using Edison Robots.

THE ARTS (MUSIC)

Students will compose, perform and respond to music of celebrations and commemorations.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION (HPE)

Students will apply skills and strategies to interact respectfully with others and enhance their own and others relationships. Students will learn fundamental skills of field hockey, including passing, trapping, dribbling, and shooting.
