WHAT IS YOUR CHILD LEARNING?

Term 1, 2025

English

Students will learn about short stories with ethical dilemmas and learn technical skills to create automated multimodal presentations.

Maths

Students will learn how to conduct statistical investigations involving different types of data. They will work with angles in degrees and use grid coordinates for locating and positioning. Students will match nets to objects and investigate transformation and symmetries.

Science

Students will learn to describe key processes that change the Earth's surface. They will work scientifically and with precision to make predictions, use equipment, organise, represent and describe data and patterns.

HASS

Students will conduct a guided inquiry into the effects of the Gold Rush in Australia.

Technologies

Students will explore elements of Design and Digital Technologies. They will be introduced to 3D printing, coding and design, using software.

Health & PE

Students will learn to explain and communicate protective behaviours and help seeking strategies on how to keep themselves and others safe online and offline. They will develop skills in Badminton and Tennis style games while focusing on teamwork, and sportsmanship.

The Arts

Students will perform, compose and respond to music featuring rhythmic ostinatos.

LOTE (Auslan)

Students will learn to present using Auslan, an introduction to their family members, including likes, dislikes and a simple physical description.
