English

Students will learn about multimodal texts and technical skills to create automated multimodal presentations.

Maths

Students will learn how to conduct statistical investigations involving different types of data. They will work with angles in degrees, use grid coordinates for locating and positioning and match nets to objects and investigate transformation and symmetries.

Science

Students will describe key processes that change the Earth's surface. They will work scientifically, with precision, to make predictions, use equipment, organise, represent and describe data, patterns and relationships.

HASS

Students will conduct an investigation around the Gold Rush in Australia looking at change, experiences and cause and effects. They will learn to locate, collect and organise information from sources and determine the origin and perspectives.

Technologies

Students will explore elements of Design and Digital Technologies. They will learn how to generate and explain design solutions for particular purposes.

Health & PE

Students will learn to explain how different factors influence identities and how stereotypes influence roles and responsibilities. They will develop basketball skills focussing on teamwork and sportsmanship.



The Arts

Students will choreograph and respond to music exploring pieces of music that tell a story and music that appears in film.

LOTE (Auslan)

Students will introduce themselves and their family members, including likes, dislikes and a simple physical description. They will identify points of information provided on the signed text.
