



YEAR 6 CURRICULUM CONNECTIONS WHAT IS YOUR CHILD LEARNING?

Term 1, 2026

English

Students will learn to read, view and listen to advertisements in print and digital media. They will develop skills to create their own multimodal advertisements.

Maths

Students will learn to use digital tools to compare distributions of categorical data and examine arguments in media statistics. They will find unknown values involving operations, investigate growing patterns and use algorithms.

Science

Students will learn how to identify the role of circuit components in the transfer and transformation of electrical energy. They will learn how energy sources help individuals and communities meet their needs.

HASS

Students will learn to develop questions to investigate Australian Federation through a guided inquiry. They will explain Australia's levels of government and democratic values using primary and secondary sources.

Technologies

Students will learn to access and use digital tools systems understanding components and data transmission. They will learn coding skills and consider digital footprint and permanence.

Health & PE

Students will learn to explain how different factors influence identities and how stereotypes influence roles and responsibilities. They will develop skills in basketball focussing on teamwork and sportsmanship.

The Arts

Students will choreograph and respond to music exploring pieces of music that tell a story and music that appears in film.

LOTE (Auslan)

Students will innovate on a nursery rhyme using Auslan signs and grammar.
