Students will explore skills for writing procedures. They will also develop skills in rehearsing and presenting the procedures in front of their peers.

Maths

Students will learn to use modelling and calculation strategies to solve problems. Students will also investigate shapes through spatial terms and locating, positioning and following directions in a 2D representation.

HASS

Students will learn to interpret, compare and sequence objects from the past and present. They will investigate the impact of changing technologies on people's lives over time.

Technologies

Students will continue to learn about the purposes of common digital systems, representing data to make meaning as well as creating and sharing information using collected data. They will also learn about algorithms helping to solve a problem.
