TERM 4, 2024

ENGLISH:

Students will be listening to, reading and viewing poems. They analyse their purpose, structure and theme. They will create poems on various topics, drawing on 'the senses' as inspiration.

MATHS:

Students will practice modelling to solve problems using multiplication and division. They will show fractions in different ways and will investigate 3D objects, angles and explore 2D maps.

SCIENCE:

Students will conduct investigations about solids and liquids changing state when heat is added or taken away. This will involve making predictions and recording observations.

HASS:

Students will continue to identify and interpret data about Australian places through different maps. They will explain the importance of making decisions democratically.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

Students will perform aquatic skills and recognise swimming strokes to complete swimming stroke sequences. They will explore water safety features and how they could be applied in the local community.

THE ARTS:

In Visual Arts, students will explore how found objects can communicate meaning in three-dimensional artworks.

TECHNOLOGIES:

In Design Technologies, students will continue to investigate modern and traditional technologies used in cooking.
